CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Your Bradley Hughes concrete sink has been sealed and waxed for protection against moisture and staining. Clean your sink with mild soap and water, and avoid using heavy abrasive, bleach based or ammoniated cleansers, which will wear down the sealer and result in less stain resistance. Felt or rubber feet pads are recommended for the bottom surfaces of all objects left to remain on the concrete. Unglazed ceramics, like terra cotta pots, will compete for residual moisture in the concrete and cause discoloration.

RE-WAXING CONCRETE

Your concrete can be re-waxed as desired to maintain it's luster. Waxing your concrete sink every 9 -12 months will provide additional protection against staining. To wax concrete, apply a thin layer with a soft cotton cloth. Allow the wax to dry approximately 3 - 4 minutes, then buff off excess wax with VERYfine grade steel wool or Scotch Brite pad. We recommend using "Palmer White" wax from Braxton Bragg
